All products in the collection are available in a choice of standard or non-standard colours, including metallic, dual colour, textured



and anodised effect finishes. The system utilises a polyamide thermal break to offer thermal efficiency that meets the latest building regulations.

An interior screening system is also available. It can be used to divide or delineate residential

and commercial spaces, while also providing an acoustic barrier. It has a choice of hinged single and double doors, as well as pivot and sliding options to accompany the fixed glazed screen. **f**

When Aperture Luxury Doors received an invitation to be part of Knutsford council's family fun day in August, the company decided a pink themed window display would work at its town centre showroom.

Inspired by the door shown on the FIT Show stand for the launch of The Residence Door Collection by Apeer, earlier this year, a specially produced pink entrance door featuring a heart-shaped glazing cassette, was highlighted by bold, pink Barbie-themed window graphics to tie in with the Barbie movie's recent release.

Aperture Doors' Lillie Pragnell says: "With the Barbie movie just being shown in cinemas at the time we decided to have fun and create this display."

Aperture Luxury Doors set up in the Cheshire town just four months ago as a spin-off from another glazing firm located in



Middlewich run by Pragnell and business partner and husband Doug Carter. She adds: "Knutsford is a very lively, wealthy town and we chose a number of luxury brands appropriate for local homeowners who are used to choosing the finer things in life. In addition to other high-end brands and despite an

emphasis on doors, we feature The Residence Collection windows in our showroom and of course, The Residence Door Collection by Apeer."

The door collection is a range of twenty styles including traditional, contemporary and stable door designs, in nine standard colours. Doors are presented in a 120mm format, with U-values from as low as 0.51W/m<sup>2</sup>K, with every door in the range below 0.75W/m<sup>2</sup>K.

Glass units, where relevant, are 78mm quadruple sealed units as standard. Construction is of GRP skins around a high-density PU core, reinforced with aluminium anti-cut through security mesh. **f**
